If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor please make your application in writing giving your reasons for wanting to join the Council and a brief letter of introduction about yourself.

Membership of the Council is open to electors who are citizens of any state in the European Union or of the Commonwealth and;

- whose residence is in Weeting or within three miles of Weeting, or;
- whose principal place of work is in Weeting; and
- who is not disqualified (by reason of a criminal record, bankruptcy or involvement in corrupt practices).

Councillors are expected to attend regular monthly meetings usually on the Third Thursday of every other month, subject to occasional rescheduling, and any additional meetings as may be agreed. Previous experience is not essential and training for Councillors can be provided.

Councillors must be comfortable to represent the electors of Weeting in raising and discussing those issues of interest and concern on which the Parish Council is empowered to act.

The deadline to apply for this vacancy is 9th May 2024.
