Brandon Road, Weeting – Drainage Improvements

Work will begin on or shortly after Monday 10 December 2018, to carry out essential drainage improvement works on Brandon Road, Weeting. It is anticipated that this work will take approximately 1 week to complete, subject to suitable weather conditions.

The work will involve construction of new ditch on the verge of Brandon Road on the eastern side, near Peppers High Hill. New gullies will be installed on the western side of Brandon Road connecting them to new ditch.

Most of the works will be carried out under 2 way lights, however Brandon Road will be closed on 13 and 14 December to dig a trench across the road to lay a new drainage pipe to connect the gullies to the new ditch. During the closure, a diversion will be in place which will be via Peppers High Hill and Mundford Road.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this drainage improvement work

is carried out. The work which will cost £5,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
