Road closure on Brandon Road, Weeting for carriageway resurfacing

Work will begin on Wednesday 23 January to carry out carriageway resurfacing works on Brandon Road, Weeting at the junction with Peppers High Hill. The work will take one day to complete subject to suitable weather conditions.

During the resurfacing works it will be necessary to close Brandon Road at the junction with Peppers High Hill to all through traffic. A fully signed official diversion route via Methwold, Mundford & Brandon will be in operation between 7.30am and 5.00pm.

Vehicle access to businesses and properties within the limits of the closure will be maintained from one end at all times. Pedestrian access will be maintained while work is underway.

The County Council would like to thank people for their patience while these works to replace the existing damaged road surface are carried out.

The work which will cost £48,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community & Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
