The Playing Field

As of the evening of 5th June 2020 , the Parish Council has opened the Playing Field for use in line with the Covid-19 Regulations with the exception of the Children's Play Area, the Gym Area, the teen shelter, Climbing Frame, Swings and the MUGA remain closed. With regard to the MUGA, it will remain closed as the rubber surface is an unknown quantity as far as the lifespan of the Covid-19 Virus so we are erring on the side of caution.

The Dog Walk is also open.

We would reiterate that the maximum size of any group is six persons and they must maintain social distancing of 2 metres between themselves unless they are from the same household. There will be no team games allowed but people from the same household can have a kick-about. There may be occasions when there is more than one group of six on the field and we would ask that you maintain distinct separation between the groups and obviously individuals not of the same household must remain two metres apart.
