## NOTICE OF COUNCILLOR VACANCY

Notice is hereby given that there is **ONE COUNCILLOR VACANCY** on the Parish Council. The Council is able to fill these vacancies by co-option (by formal vote from the Parish Councillors).

If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor and would like to join our friendly team of councillors please make your application in writing giving your reasons for wanting to join the Council and a brief background about yourself. Membership of the Council is open to electors who are citizens of any state in the European Union or of the Commonwealth and;

- whose residence is in Weeting or within three miles of Weeting or;
- whose principal place of work is in Weeting; and
- who is not disqualified (by reason of a criminal record, bankruptcy or involvement in corrupt practices).

Councillors are expected to attend regular monthly meetings on the third Thursday evening of each month, subject to occasional rescheduling, and any additional meetings as may be agreed. Previous experience is not essential and training for Councillors can be provided. Councillors must be

comfortable to represent the electors of Weeting in raising and discussing those issues of interest and concern on which the Parish Council is empowered to act. There is no deadline for the position but consideration of applications will be made on a rolling basis and those received will each be considered by the Parish Council at its public meetings until the position is filled.

Any elector interested in applying is welcome to contact the Clerk for an informal chat and further details.
