

The Norfolk County Council
(Weeting-with-Broomhill, C873 Brandon Road, Main Road, Lynn Road)
(30 M.P.H. and 40 M.P.H. Speed Limits) Order 2024

The Norfolk County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the current 30mph speed limit along the C873 Lynn Road north-westwards by 300m to replace the current 40mph speed limit by the same distance.

The Norfolk County Council (Weeting-with-Broomhill, C873 Brandon Road) (30 M.P.H and 40 M.P.H Speed Limits) Order 2003 ('the 2003 Order') will become revoked on commencement of this Order.

Any objections and representations relating to the Order must be made in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made.
